COMMENTS & OBSERVATIONS

- 1. Inspected finished elevation at Unit 9. Trim and siding are installed per specifications. Flashing and belly band terminations are of exceptional quality.
- 2. Mick is completing siding installation on Units 33 through 36 and plans to move loft scaffolding to Units 29 through 32 tomorrow. (1/6/11)
- 3. 8 gable ends on Lower Level Units remain unfinished. Mick will complete those areas in conjunction with Loft Level work. With waterproofing in place, there shouldn't be concerns regarding leaks, moisture, etc.
- 4. Snow has been removed from the roof of the maintenance shed in anticipation of work on Unit 1 End Elevation. Occupants will be in the unit until Saturday.
- 5. Approximately 11 inches of snow was reported in the last 7 days.
- 6. Upper Level dumpster is still on site. Snow has delayed the pick-up. The area is congested with snow removed from the parking lot. During a brief conversation with Tofer (CBL) that area should be addressed soon but is not critical.
