- 1. Reviewed progress on horizontal siding installation on Lower Level Units. Unit 23 is now complete. Electrical conduit has been reattached to the buildings in all locations and appears secure.
- 2. Observed Loft Window replacement on Units. New windows are in place and window & corner trim is being installed. Metal siding is partially installed on Units 40 and 39.
- 3. Inspected Unit 9; lower horizontal metal siding is in place. Corner trim and belly bands are installed per the drawings.
- 5. The site is clean and well organized. Both the Upper and Lower Level dumpsters are full. Dumpsters will be removed from the site by December 17th.
